

Highland Elementary Registration 2008-2009

Registration for the school year 2008-2009 at Highland Elementary will be Wednesday August 13, 2008. Registration packets may be picked up on Monday August 11, 2008. The following registration schedule will be used in the Highland cafeteria:

I-M 10:00 – 12 noon

N-S 12 noon – 2:00

T-Z 2:00 – 4:00

These forms should be completed, signed and returned to Highland Elementary when registering a child:

1. **Registration Form** – Please provide basic information. **Parent signature required**
2. **Emergency card** - (for the nurse's office) – Identify someone who will be available during the school day and has a local telephone number. **Parent signature required.**
3. **Student insurance** –. Must be returned whether or not enrolling in the program. **Parent signature required.**
4. **Free/Reduced meal application** – if applicable. **Parent signature required.**
5. **Field trip permission and release form.** **Parent signature required.**
6. **School party sign-up sheet.**
7. **Migrant survey** – All students. **Parent signature required.**
8. **Electronic Communication agreement** – All students. **Parent signature required.**
9. **Home Language Survey** – (new students to Highland only) **Parent signature required.**
10. **Tulia ISD Student Residency Questionnaire** – All students. McKinney-Vento Education Assistance Act of 2001.
11. **Parent Involvement Survey-** **Parent signature required.**
12. **Acknowledgment Form-** **Parent signature required.**
13. **Notice of Directory Information-** **Parent signature needed in two places.**

New students to Highland Elementary need to bring immunization record, birth certificate, and social security card.

For prospective Headstart students, an application must be completed before admittance to Headstart (**Parent signature required**). Students must meet guidelines to qualify for the Headstart program. Children that are 4 years old by Sept 1st may attend Tulia ISD Tuition Based Early Childhood Program if families do not qualify for Headstart. Highland's school nurse will be available on August 13, 2008 to look over immunizations of new students.
