

WHAT IS TITLE I?



The Title I program is designed to meet the specific needs of the eligible children attending our school. Title I programs are also designed to improve the educational opportunities of underachieving children and help them:

- ❖ succeed in the regular program.
- ❖ attain grade level proficiency.
- ❖ improve their achievement in the basic and more advanced skills.

Title I support programs include parental involvement, counseling, health care, and other social services. In addition, certain educational programs are available to pupils who live in target areas and attend private schools, and to those neglected children who reside in institutions designated by the Texas Education Agency.



THE LAW...

The most recent law that affects Title I is *Improving America's Schools Act* (Public Law 103-382 H.R. 6). The law required:

- ❖ that school districts have a written policy regarding parental involvement.
- ❖ that parents be involved in the design, operation, and evaluation of Title I.
- ❖ that parents be consulted about home/school activities operation, and evaluation of Title I.
- ❖ that parents be consulted about home school activities and be trained to help their children.
- ❖ that whenever possible, activities should be presented in the language spoken by the majority of Title I parents.

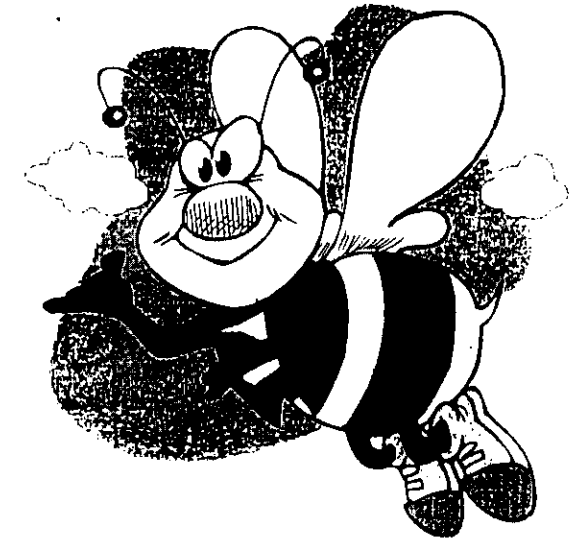
